AWARD OF THE 2016 SULTAN HASSANAL BOLKIAH INTERNATIONAL PRIZE IN ISLAMIC FINANCE

The 2016 Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah International Prize in Islamic Finance has been awarded to the Islamic Development Bank as an institution and to HE Dr Ahmad Mohamed Al-Madani, in his personal capacity.

It was the unanimous decision of an International Jury that the 2016 Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah International Prize in Islamic Finance should be awarded to the Islamic Development Bank as an institution and to HE Dr Ahmad Mohamed Al-Madani in view of his outstanding personal contribution.

The Islamic Development Bank is the world's leading international Islamic finance institution, established in 1975 to foster the economic development and social progress of its 56 members spread over four continents. The bank provides loans and grants to finance productive activities in key economic sectors.
